THURSDAY 18TH APRIL FRAMLINGHAM CASTLE AND WOODBRIDGE

Walk the 10 metres high walls of this Tudor castle, built in the 1190s, once the home of dukes and earls of Norfolk. Also home of the Bigods, Mowbrays and Howards. Mary Tudor was also a visitor here in 1553 when she was crowned Queen. After time in the town, we stop at Woodbridge on the way home.

SATURDAY 11TH MAY LIVING CRAFTS AT HATFIELD HOUSE, HERFORDSHIRE

100s of artists and designers. Workshops and demonstrations. Try your hand at a new skill. Free access to the estate's gardens and woodlands. Food and music.

Cost – Adult £35, Child £30 Coach and entry

THURSDAY 13TH JUNE THE COCKNEY MATINEE, ROYAL DOCKS, LONDON

Based on the Teresa Joanne boat, this is an afternoon of traditional entertainment with a three-piece Cockney band, which will have you singing, waving flags, and doing the conga and the Hokey Cokey. With a two course lunch and drink, you are assured of an enjoyable afternoon. When booking, ask for a menu.

WEDNESDAY 31ST JULY SANDRINGHAM FLOWER SHOW, NORFOLK

East Anglia's premier flower show, held on the Sandringham Estate. Dozens of stalls, marquees, demonstrations, entertainment etc. With a "walk about" with King Charles. The grounds, museum and church are open.

Depart 8.30a.m. Return 6.30p.m.

Cost – £45 Coach and entry

WEDNESDAY 21ST AUGUST LEISTON LONG SHOP MUSEUM AND ALDEBURGH, SUFFOLK

The museum celebrates the Garrett family who moved to Leiston in 1778 and started manufacturing agricultural machinery and steam engines in the early 19th century. Also the famous Garrett woman, Elizabeth Garrett Anderson, the first UK female doctor and Millicent Fawcett Garrett, a famous suffragette. We then move on to the coastal town of Aldeburgh.

Depart 9.00a.m. Return 6.00p.m.

Cost - £35 Coach and entry

THURSDAY 10TH OCTOBER CANTERBURY CATHEDRAL

Founded in 597 AD, it is one of the most visited places in the country. In 1170, Archbishop Thomas Becket was murdered here, and soon after miracles were said to take place.

Depart 9.00a.m. Return 6.00p.m.

Cost - £42 Coach and entry

WEDNESDAY 18TH DECEMBER THURSFORD CHRISTMAS SPECTACTULAR

The largest and best Christmas show in England. Singers, dancers, musicians and comedy. With a lunch stop at Swaffham. *For this trip only, we require £45 deposit to cover the cost of the ticket.*
